

Streptavidin FITC-conjugated**Cat-No.: S12131F****0.1 ml****Description:**

SA-FITC is a useful second-step reagent for indirect immunofluorescent staining in combination with biotinylated primary antibodies.

Formulation:

Phosphate buffered saline with 15mM sodium azide, pH 7.2.

Stability:

Store as an undiluted liquid at 4°C. Do not freeze. Avoid prolonged exposure to light. The reagent is stable until the expiry date stated on the vial label.

Usage:

The reagent is useful for Flow Cytometry analysis. It is recommended that the reagent should be titrated for each particular testing systems. Dilute only prior to immediate use.

Warning:

Sodium azide is harmful if swallowed (R22). Keep out of reach of children (S2). Keep away from food, drink and animal feedingstuff (S13). Wear suitable protective clothing (S36). If swallowed, seek medical advice immediately and show this container or label (S46). Contact with acids liberates very toxic gas (R32). Azide compounds should be flushed with large volumes of water during disposal to avoid deposits in lead or copper plumbing where explosive conditions can develop.
